Round Barns / Dairy Farm Historic District

Upon its chartering February 28, 1867, the Illinois Industrial University became a model of the Land Grant University, transforming the "treeless prairie" into a world-renowned agricultural and engineering school. Built between 1907 and 1913, the three Round Barns anchored the 20-acre dairy demonstration farm and were added to the Historic Register in 1994.

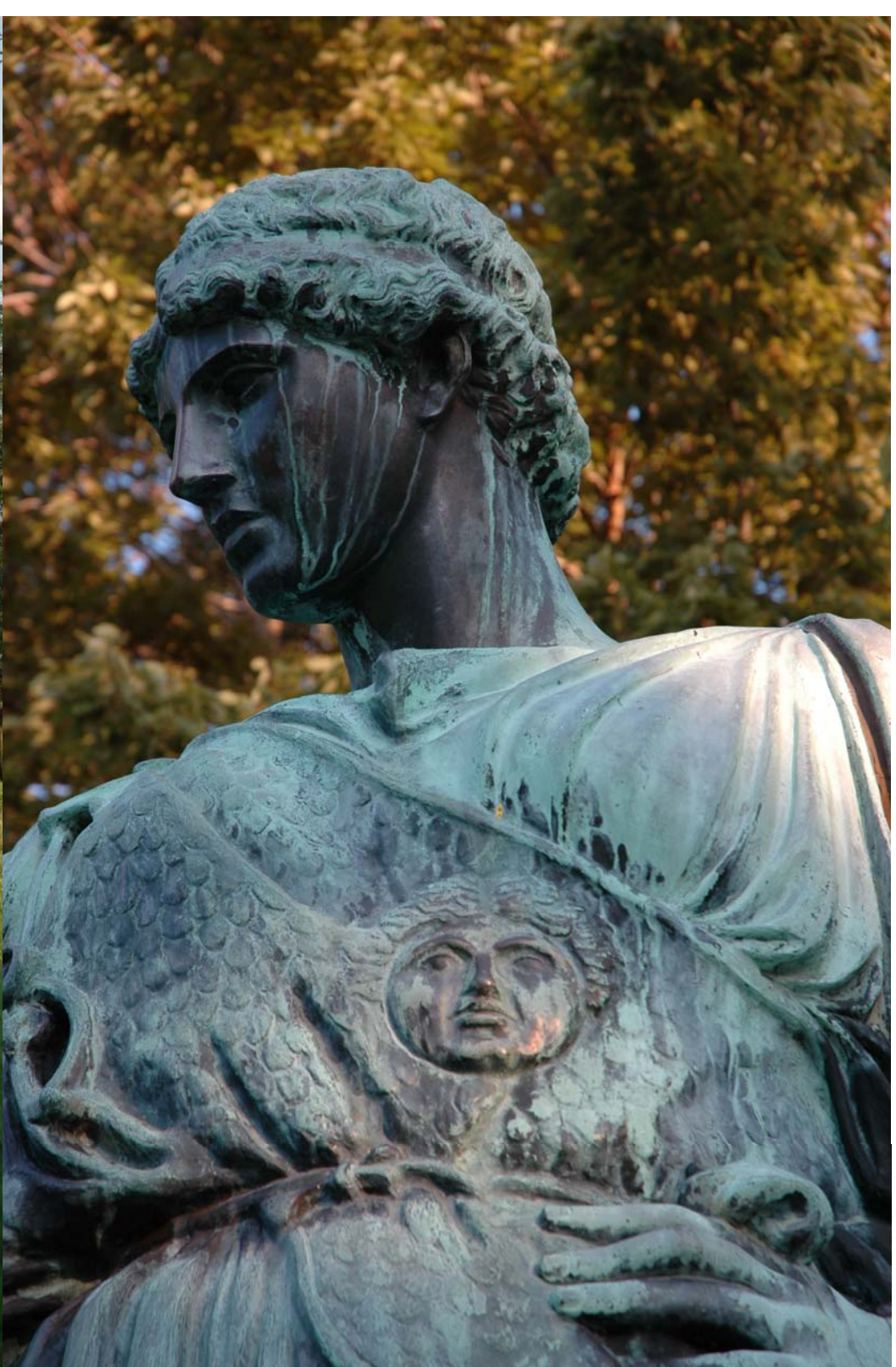
English Building

Dedicated October 16, 1905, the Women's Building shared its dedication with the installation of incoming UI President Edmund James James and was one of the earliest women's dormitories on campus. In 1947 it was renamed Bevier Hall until completion of the new Bevier Hall in 1956, at which time it was renamed to the English Building.
