**AMENDMENT**

to

**By-Laws for University of Illinois Student Section  
of SOCIETY OF WOMEN ENGINEERS**

**Article II**

**Section 3.** All student members must be enrolled in an engineering curriculum or the physical sciences (e.g., mathematics, geology, astronomy, physics, and chemistry).

(a) All engineering members shall be voting members.

(b) The non-engineering members shall be divided into voting and non-voting members. The number of voting, non-engineering members shall be one less than the number of engineering members. They shall be proportioned as follows: each non-engineering department represented among the members shall have one voting member, who shall be the member of longest standing in the society from that department. The other voting, non-engineering members shall be picked according to length of membership in the society, regardless of department.
