To Captain Thomas J. Smith, a lawyer of Champaign, belongs the distinction of having made the largest contribution of any private citizen to the State University. In 1914 Captain Smith gave \$215,000 in Illinois lands to the University of Illinois for the purpose of erecting a memorial building that should be dedicated to music and that should be in memory and honor of his wife who died in August 1903.
